To cite a chapter in a book in a reference entry in APA style 6th edition include the following elements: Author (s) of the chapter: Give the last name and initials (e. g. Watson, J. D.) of up to seven authors with the last... Year of publication: Give the year in brackets followed by a full stop. ...

### APA: how to cite a chapter in a book [Update 2020 ...

Chapter in an edited book, reprinted from another book Do not create references for chapters of authored books. Instead, write a reference for the whole authored book and cite the chapter in the text if desired.

### Edited Book Chapter References - APA Style

Citing a chapter in the APA format is the trickiest part, because edited books are a collection of different chapters from different authors and different books. Even the slightest slip-up can result in you citing the wrong author with the chapter, so it is necessary to be careful to avoid any plagiarism.

### How to Cite a Chapter in a Book in APA Format in Text - A ...

The edition is added by adding the number and the abbreviation for edition, which is "ed." Add a period and comma after ed. Then, add the page numbers of the chapter, which are preceded by the abbreviation for pages, which is "pp." Place in parentheses, and add a period after the parentheses.

### How to create an APA Chapter Citation - EasyBib.com

Put the author's last name in the parenthetical citation if you omit it in the quote intro. If you don't refer to the name of the book chapter's author in the quote introduction, you need to include the last name in the parenthetical in-text citation that follows the quote. For example: " (O'Neil, 1992, p. 111).".

APA Format Broken Down: Use this format if you are using 1 chapter out of a book that has many chapters, and each chapter is written by a different author. If each chapter is written by the same author, just cite the entire book. Parts of the APA Citation Explanation Author's Last name, First initial. Middle initial. Example: Hager, R. J.

### How To Cite a Chapter From a Book in APA Format

Author(s) of chapter - family name and initials, use & for multiple authors. (Year). Title of chapter. In Editor(s) - initial(s) and family name - of book (Ed. OR Eds.), Title of book - italicised (pp. Page numbers). Publisher. DOI or Web address (if available) In-text reference: Use the chapter authors, NOT the editors of the book

Middle initial. (Year published). Chapter title. In First initial. Middle initial. Last name of Editor (Ed.), Book title (pp. xx-xx). Publisher. Example: De ...

### Chapter in a Book - APA Citation Style, 6th Edition ...

The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

### **How to Cite a Book in APA Style | Formats & Examples**

(Year of publication). Title of chapter. In Editor(s) – initial(s) and family name - of book (Ed. OR Eds.), Title of book – italicised (pp. Page numbers). Place of publication: Publisher. In-text reference: Use the chapter authors, NOT the editors of the book. Treat multiple authors in same format as books (Baker & Lightfoot, 1993 ...

### **Book chapter - APA 6th referencing style - Library Guides ...**

Note: When citing in-text, it can be difficult if your eBook does not have a page number (most PDF books do). In this case, try to get as specific as possible by mentioning chapter, section, and paragraph numbers. One of the author's main points is that "people don't rise from nothing" (Gladwell, 2008, Chapter 1, Section 2, para. 5).

### **Book Examples - APA (7th edition) Citation Guide ...**

If the book includes a DOI, include the DOI in the reference after the publisher name. Do not include the publisher location. If the book does not have a DOI and is an ebook from an academic research database, end the book reference after the publisher name. Do not include database information in the reference. The reference in this case is the ...

### **Book References - APA Style**

Citing Online/eBooks in APA Style When citing online books and eBooks, the publisher location and name are replaced with a web site address. The web site address should be the home page URL of the digital library or publisher.

### **Article or Chapter in an Edited Book - APA Citation Style ...**

When referring to a chapter in an authored book, usually you would not cite that chapter in the reference list. Instead, you would cite the whole book and, if necessary, cite the chapter in text. This rule applies whether the chapter is written by one of the book's primary authors or by a separate contributor. Even though it might seem sensible to cite that chapter as one would cite a chapter from an edited book, doing
