It's last official name was the Newark State School. It's first name, when opened in -- 1876, was New York Custodial Asylum for Feeble-Minded Women. It was at first and experimental extension of the State mental hospital at Syracuse, but early on separated from that operational affiliation, to a self-managed entity.

Unknown Asylum | Abandoned Finger Lakes

History. The New York State Custodial Asylum for Feeble-Minded Women reflected a shift in belief that almshouses (poorhouses) were improper places for "feeble-minded" women. It was thought that feeble-minded women in almshouse settings acted promiscuously, and as a result frequently had illegitimate children who, then became dependent on the state for their welfare.

The Rome Custodial Asylum is entirely owned and maintained by the State of New York for the care and treatment of feeble-minded and idiotic persons, the following classes being cared for: All of both sexes below the age of seven; all of both sexes between the ages of seven and fourteen who are physically infirm (the ablebodied feeble-minded children who can use language between the ages of seven and fourteen are sent to the Syracuse School for feeble-minded), and cases past the age of ...

History. Opened in 1827 as the Oneida County Poorhouse, The Rome State Custodial Asylum began as a 2 story building on the outskirts of Lynchville to house paupers and the insane.
